

Yawgoog Scout Reservation Refund Policy 2011

Refunds should be requested in writing during a unit's check-in or during the unit's week at Camp. Refunds should be requested by a registered member of the unit's leadership.

If approved, all refunds for Scouts camping with chartered units will be mailed directly to the leader of record of that unit from the Narragansett Council's Providence office within thirty days of the request.

For Scouts attending the Webelos, Baden-Powell or Counselor-in-Training Corps programs, properly requested approved refunds will be mailed directly to the Scouts' parents.

The following are conditions for authorized refunds (written documentation may be required):

1. Illness of Scout/Leader prevents attendance.
2. Illness or death in the family of the Scout/Leader prevents his/her attendance.
3. A Scout family move makes attendance impractical.
4. A Scout must attend summer school.

Written documentation for any of the above will be required.

The following payments are non-refundable:

1. Troop site deposit fee of \$250.
2. Troop confirmation fee of \$500.
3. Deposit fee for Provisional Camps of \$25.00 per week.
4. Hat incentive payment of \$25.00.
5. Refunds will not be issued to units planning an early departure.
6. Leader fees without proper documentation

Refunds may be requested for Scouts who must leave Camp early for personal or medical reasons. Again, written documentation may be required. *Homesickness does not constitute a refundable medical reason.*

Refunds for Adult Leaders: Your site will be set up according to your final payment worksheet. You will be charged for the number of adult leaders in that sheet. In the event a leader cannot attend, proper documentation must be provided.

All refunds are subject to the discretion of the Reservation Director.
