## 2024 Troop Activities & Competitions



### WELCOME CAMPFIRE (SUNDAY)

Join the Three Point staff at 8pm in the Three Point Amphitheater as we kick off the week with a great campfire accompanied by some skits and songs! Perfect view of the sunset with laughs and singing! We start with campsite attendance promptly at 8 PM.

### SILVER CY & SPL CRACKER BARREL (MONDAY)

This event will occur in the Medicine Bow Dining Hall at 8:15 pm. It is required for Silver CY Candidates, Senior Patrol Leader, and open for any senior youth leaders in the troop who may want to attend.
