

Camp Yawgoog 2025 Fees

Troops:

Adventure Card Scout: \$600 per Scout

Out-of-Council Scouts: \$625 per Scout

Adult Leader Price*: \$325 per additional adult

*3 Adults are **free** for each troop attending

1 additional Adult is free for every 12 Scouts attending.

Provisional:

Fun Friends Adventure Camp: (\$625 first week, \$400 additional weeks)

Yawgoog Leadership Experience: (\$300 first week, \$200 additional weeks)

Webelos Outdoor Adventure Full Week: (\$625 first week, \$400 additional weeks)

Webelos Outdoor Adventure Half Week (Sun-Wed OR Wed-Sat): \$375

Discounts

Sibling Discount: \$50

Yawgoog offers a discount to families that send two or more siblings to camp. The discount is \$50 for each sibling. This does not apply to the Yawgoog Leadership Experience or an already discounted additional week of camp.

High Adventure Discount: \$100

Sea Base/ Philmont/Northern Tier/Summit discount: Yawgoog will offer a discount of \$100 for Scouts that attend one of these High Adventure programs. Proper documentation (receipt) must be provided. When using this discount, no other discounts apply.

Additional Week Discount: \$200

An additional Week Discount can Be used for any Scout who is spending a second week at camp this summer. This discount is eligible for Scouts whose first week is at any resident Scout camp. When using this discount, no other discounts apply. (*Discount is limited to the Fun Friends Adventure program*)

Troop Payment Schedule

Campsite Deposit - \$500

The campsite deposit is made when the troop registers to attend Yawgoog. This will add the troop into the Yawgoog Office Management System, reserving a campsite for the upcoming season. This also provides the point of contact for the troop with a monthly email keeping them up to date on policy changes, program updates, and the latest information about attending Yawgoog this summer.

Hat Incentive Deposit – minimum of \$500 Due February 28th.

The hat incentive Deposit is a \$500 minimum payment that confirms the troop is registered for the upcoming season as well as provides an opportunity for the troop to receive free incentive hats for the year by depositing money. Putting more money down in February can only help the troop when camp is coming along. All payments provided at this time (except embroidery fees) are credited toward final fees.

Final Fees – 30 days in advance

Final Fees are due 30 days prior to the troop's week at camp. At this point in time all paperwork should be submitted through Black Pug registration system. Leaders should be up to date with Youth Protection Training. Health forms should be submitted and 100% complete with up-to-date part C's.

Late Fees - \$25 fee for late payments and paperwork. Fees and forms are due 30 days in advance of arrival.

Camperships/Discounts - Only one campership or discount can be applied per Scout. If extenuating circumstances arise and additional help is needed, please contact campyawgoog@scouting.org
