## WEEKLY EVENTS IN CAMP THREE POINT

#### TROOP TOURNAMENT

#### SILVER CY CRACKER BARREL (TUESDAY)

This event will occur in the Medicine Bow Dining Hall at 8:15 pm. It is required for Silver CY Candidates, Senior Patrol Leader, and open for any senior youth leaders in the troop who may want to attend.
