### **Troop Tournament (Every Day!)**

Get ready to compete head-to-head with other troops each day after lunch in a certain sporting event. Events could include field, water, or maybe even some scout skills competitions!

### **Welcome Campfire (Sunday)**

Join the Three Point staff at 8 PM in the Three Point Amphitheater as we kick off the week with a great campfire accompanied by some skits and songs! Sing and laugh in front of the sunset, with campsite attendance starting promptly at 8 PM!

### **Silver CY / SPL Cracker Barrel (Monday)**

This event will occur in the Medicine Bow Dining Hall at 8:15 PM. It is required for Silver CY Candidates, Senior Patrol Leaders, and open for any senior youth leaders in the troop who may want to attend. The Program Commissioners and Yawgoog Leadership Experience Staff will be providing the scouts a variety of skills and knowledge to develop their leadership capability!!!
