Our Code of Honor

Camp Yawgoog is a special place where Scouts of all backgrounds— from across the country and around the world—come together to seek adventure and to live the Scout Oath and Law. Every Scout helps make Yawgoog safe, friendly, and welcoming for all.

At Camp Yawgoog, I Promise to Be a Scout with Honor:

- I will do my best to live the Scout Oath, Scout Law, Outdoor Code, Slogan, and Motto.
- Trustworthy: I will respect the privacy and property of other Scouts and adults in bathrooms, showers, tents, cabins/Adirondacks and in common areas.
- Courteous: I will treat everyone with respect. Inappropriate comments, touching, staring, or invading personal space are not acceptable.
- Friendly: I will be welcoming, positive, and friendly to all Scouts, leaders, and staff. No name-calling, insults, threats or bad-natured teasing.
- Clean: I will use clean and respectful language. I will not make jokes, insults, skits, or songs based on race, religion, ethnicity, gender, or abilities.
- Kind: I will be welcoming to new Scouts and build others up.
- Brave: I will be an upstander—I will speak up for others. I will admit mistakes and make things right.
- Reverent: I will stand in silence and reverence and remove my hat when the bell tolls at noon each day to remember Scouts who died for God and country.

Yawgoog Scouts Are “Upstanders”!

When I see someone being treated unkindly, I will be an upstander. I will speak up, offer support, and report concerns to a trusted leader such as your SPL, Scoutmaster, or a staff member.

Actions That Will Get Me Sent Home

Behavior that violates the Code of Honor or the Scout Oath and Law may result in discipline, including being sent home at my own expense and possible loss of membership in my troop and Scouting America. The following actions **will** result in being sent home:

Physical violence, threats or fighting	Invading privacy or peeking in the bathrooms, showers, tents or Adirondacks	Climbing on the roof of a dining hall
Any sexual activity	Being out of our campsite after 9:45 PM	Youth Protection violations
Hazing or initiation rites of any kind	Possession of or use of alcohol, marijuana, or illegal drugs	Bullying, intimidation, or use of racial slurs
